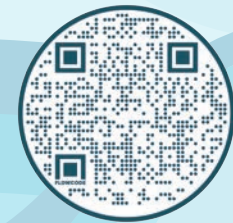

Benefits of Membership

- The Long Beach Art League (LBAL) presents informative programs/meetings on the first Wednesday evening of each month excluding July and August. Meetings are at the Long Beach Public Library 2nd Floor Auditorium from 7:00 - 8:30PM and sometimes via ZOOM. Members are notified about the programs by email, a monthly newsletter and social media.
- A priority of LBAL is quality learning experiences for our members. Programs feature professional artists who share their techniques, knowledge and experiences. Other instructional events include workshops, demonstrations, lectures and movies related to art.
- Members may exhibit their art regularly at the 2nd Floor Gallery of the Long Beach Public Library and online on the LBAL website. Several times a year, a professional artist is invited to judge the exhibition and prizes are awarded.
- Members may participate in any exhibits, sponsored by the LBAL, at other libraries and locations.
- A monthly newsletter, THE PALETTE, provides resources for artists and news about members as well as information on our group exhibits and programs/meetings. Details on opportunities for artists, articles on art techniques and history, local museum exhibits information, dates and locations of open Studio Time, etc. are also published.
- Members may display and sell their artwork at the LBAL tent during the Arts in the Plaza season. This weekly outdoor festival takes place at Kennedy Plaza in Long Beach on Saturdays from the end of May through the end of October.
- Members can have a link from the LBAL website to his/her website at no charge. They may also publicize their artwork on the LBAL website for a one-time nominal fee. Each artist may post a photo of themselves, a short bio and six images of artwork.
- Members may publicize their exhibits, programs and accomplishments on the LBAL Facebook page and the monthly newsletter, THE PALETTE.
