## **LONG BEACH ART LEAGUE EXHIBIT RULES**

**By exhibiting your work in a LBAL show you agree to the terms and requirements below and agree that a photograph of yourself, your art work and your name may be published on the LBAL's website or Facebook page.**

### **TERMS**

- Artists entering a LBAL show must hold current LBAL membership.
- Entry must be original work by the artist.
- The LBAL Receiving Committee reserves the right to refuse any artwork.
- The LBAL or the Long Beach Public Library are not responsible for theft or damage to pieces displayed. It is the responsibility of the artist to insure their works.

### **FRAMING AND PRESENTATION**

- Work on canvas may be unframed if the edges are painted as an integral part of the work, otherwise it needs to be framed.
- Work on paper must be framed with glass/Plexiglas.
- Work with mats/glass must have clean mats and clean/non-scratched glass or Plexiglas.
- Frames must be sturdy and wired for hanging. No saw-tooth hangers allowed.
- Work cannot be larger than 42" in either direction.
- Unusual framing or display situations must be approved by LBAL Receiving Committee before submission.

### **SHOW PERIOD AND PICK UP**

- Work must remain displayed for the duration of the show.
- Work cannot be moved/repositioned once the show has been hung unless performed by the LBAL Board.
- The LBAL will monitor art work pick up to help ensure someone does not take art which does not belong to them.
- Pick up date and hours are published in the LBAL Newsletter or you may call/email the LBAL President or Vice President for information.
- The Long Beach Library will allow storage in one of their offices in the event an artist cannot make the pick up day. To discourage this practice a storage fee of \$25 will be imposed for work not picked up during the pick up hours/day.
